

REGULATION  
ON THE MANNER OF MARKING, CONTENT AND APPEARANCE OF SIGNS USED TO  
MARK THE BUSINESS PREMISES OF THE ORGANISER SUBJECT TO A PROHIBITING  
THE ORGANISATION OF SPECIAL GAMES OF CHANCE

“Official Gazette RS” no. 37 dated 23 April 2025

Article 1

This regulation provides for the manner of marking, content and appearance of signs of the Games of Chance Administration, used to visibly mark the business premises of an organiser against whom a measure prohibiting the organisation of special games of chance is imposed, in accordance with Article 123 of the Law on Law on Games of Chance (“Official Gazette RS” no. 18/20 and 94/24) (hereinafter: the Law).

Article 2

The business premises of an organiser subject to the measure prohibiting organisation of special games of chance are marked with a notice, tape and a poster of Games of Chance Administration.

Article 3

The notice referred to in Article 2 hereof is in the shape of horizontal rectangle and printed in A4 format, i.e. 21 cm x 29.7 cm in size.

The background of the notice referred to in paragraph 1 above is white, while the content of the notice is printed in black letters.

The appearance and content of the notice referred to in paragraph 1 above are provided in Form OB UIS – Notice of the Games of Chance Administration, which is printed with this Regulation and represents its integral part.

The notice referred to in paragraph 1 above is displayed at the entrance and on the other external surfaces of the building premises in which special games of chance are organised and which are subject to inspection.

Article 4

The tape referred to in Article 2 above is made of fluorescent PVC self-adhesive film, up to 10 cm wide, bearing the text: „GAMES OF CHANCE ADMINISTRATION” in fluorescent white letters.

The total length of the text referred to in paragraph 1 above will be up to 40 cm, with a spacing of up to 20 cm between each repetition of the text.

The appearance of the tape referred to in paragraph 1 above is provided in Form TR UIS – Tape of the Games of Chance Administration, which is printed with this Regulation and represents its integral part.

#### Article 5

The poster referred to in Article 2 hereof is in the shape of horizontal rectangle and printed in A4 format, i.e. 21 cm x 29.7 cm in size.

The poster referred to in paragraph 1 above is made on a white background, with text and graphic illustrations in black and white, along with the coat of arms of the Republic of Serbia.

The appearance and content of the poster referred to in paragraph 1 above are provided in Form PL UIS – Poster of the Games of Chance Administration, which is printed with this Regulation and represents its integral part.

The poster referred to in paragraph 1 above is displayed at the entrance of business premises in which special games of chance are organised and which are subject to inspection.

#### Article 6

During the inspection, the inspector of the Games of Chance Administration may display the decision on prohibition of organising special games of chance at the entrance to the business premises where special games of chance are organised, together with the notice and poster referred to in Articles 3 and 5 hereof.

#### Article 7

Provisions of this Regulation that govern the contents and appearance of the notice, tape and poster of Games of Chance Administration are dully applied in cases of sealing of business premises and facilities in which special games of chance are organised without authorisation within the meaning of Article 122, paragraph 4 of the Law.

#### Article 8

This Regulation enters into force on the eighth day after its publication in the “Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia“.
